### Visit Options

We can offer half-day (morning or afternoon) or full day visits to the Sanctuary, to best suit your group's needs and wishes.

### Whichever option you choose:

- All the members of your group will have the opportunity to experience healing for themselves, with our experienced and fully qualified healers.
- A Healing Sanctuary host will be available for the duration of your visit. Your host's aim is to ensure that your group has a wonderful and memorable time whilst at the Sanctuary.

## Example Programmes

Please note that the timings shown below are approximate and may need to be adjusted depending on the number of individuals in your group.

### Morning Visit Only

- 10.15 Arrival
- 10.30 Welcome: Enjoy morning tea or coffee and cakes provided by us in the beautiful surroundings of Burrows Lea Country House. Listen to a presentation on the history of Harry Edwards, the Sanctuary, and the nature of the work we do. This interesting and informative presentation includes a demonstration by a healer and a chance for members of your group to ask any questions they may have.

- 11.30 Presentation and guided tour of the Harry Edwards Healing Sanctuary. Confirmation of (optional) healing appointments
- 12.30 Lunch. We encourage groups to bring their own picnic to enjoy in our gardens and grounds. Outdoor seating is provided, and indoor seating can be made available if the weather is poor.
- 13.30 Healing appointments in the old Sanctuary Chapel
- 15.15 Tea or coffee and cakes provided by us in the beautiful surroundings of Burrows Lea Country House
- 16.00 Departure

The small gift shop in our purpose-built healing centre will be open so that any members of your group who wish to purchase a memento of their visit to the Sanctuary may do so.

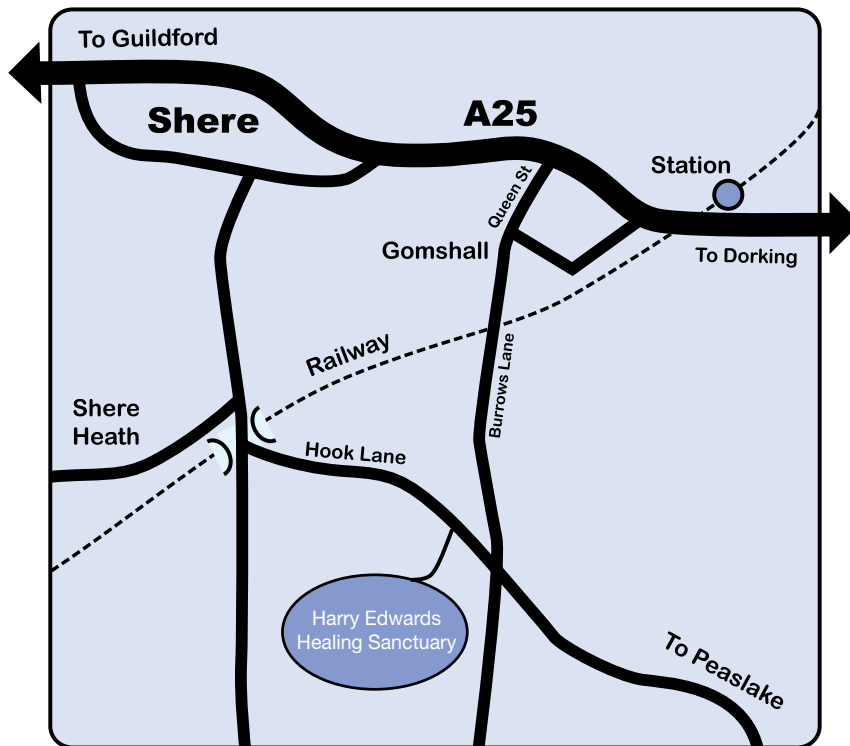
## **Minimum Numbers and Visit Costs**

There is a four person minimum for both the half-day visit and the full day visit.

The half-day visit (morning or afternoon) costs £7.50 per head and the full day visit costs £10.00 per head (Excluding transport). These charges cover the cost of the refreshments arrangements and the group experience whilst at the Sanctuary. Please note that we never charge for our healing services.

## Directions to the Harry Edwards Healing Sanctuary

### BY RAIL:

We are about one and a half miles from the nearest railway station which is in the village of Gomshall. This is a small unmanned station which has no public telephone or taxi service. The nearest mainline stations are Guildford and Dorking and taxis are available from both these stations.

### BY ROAD:

From Guildford, take the A25 to Dorking for about five miles until you reach the village of Gomshall. Turn right opposite immediately opposite petrol station, carry straight on over a level crossing and continue up the hill (about half a mile) until you reach Burrows Cross crossroads. Turn right (sign posted Burrows Lea). The entrance to the Sanctuary is the first driveway on the left and is clearly marked).

From Dorking, take the A25 to Guildford for about seven miles until you reach the village of Gomshall. After passing under a railway arch, take the second turning on the left, opposite the petrol station, carry straight on over a level crossing, and continue up the hill (about half a mile) until you reach Burrows Cross crossroads. Turn right into Hook Lane (sign posted Burrows Lea). The entrance to the Sanctuary is the first driveway on the left and is clearly marked).

From Horsham, take the A281 (signed Cranleigh/Guildford) to Rudgwick. Take the the A29 sign posted Dorking/Ockley. Take the first turning left sign posted Rowhook and Ewhurst. Follow the road and drive through Ewhurst village to another mini roundabout with the Bulls Head pub on your right, and take the exit directly opposite - Shere Road. Go straight on up a steep hill (Pitch Hill) passing the Windmill pub on your left. The road narrows to become single track with passing places, continue on this road taking the next turning on the right, just before Railway Bridge. This is Hook Lane and is signposted to Peaslake and to Burrows Lea. The Sanctuary is approximately half a mile on the right and is clearly marked - ignore an earlier sign on the right for Burrows Lea Farm.
